Dear Stakeholder

The State Planning Commission (the Commission) has released the draft **Far North Regional Plan** (the Plan) and are seeking feedback from community, councils and industry on the Plan and how, through its application, we sustainably prepare for future growth in the region.

Public consultation of the Plan will run for 12 weeks, commencing **Wednesday 12 February 2025** and closes on the **7 May 2025**.

The purpose of the consultation is to allow an opportunity to comment on the Plan. Regional plans play an important role in guiding sustainable growth by identifying land use and long-term infrastructure over a 15 to 30-year period. They outline where new housing and employment areas will be located, how services will be delivered, and what infrastructure is needed while exploring different growth scenarios.

The Plan highlights the challenges and opportunities that exist for regional and remote communities, identifying the need for reliable connections between communities and recognises future opportunities in industry, mining, tourism and agriculture. The Plan does this by focusing on five key themes:

- People, housing and liveability
- Productive economy
- Environment, natural resources and landscapes
- Transport and infrastructure
- Implementation and delivery

The Commission invite all stakeholders, including industry, government and the community, to provide feedback on the Plan during the consultation period, to help refine and better meet the medium to long-term land use needs of the region.
