This is presented to the person or group who has staged the most outstanding or beneficial event/service for their community.

To be eligible, the person or group must be Australian Citizens.

Senior Citizen of the Year

This is presented to someone who continues to achieve and contribute to their community.

To be eligible, the person must be an Australian Citizen aged 65 years and over on January 26, 2023.
