The participants were encouraged to draw their ideas on paper and Allan with local Artist Rowena Williams helped them project their ideas onto the tyres.


Allan and the young people had been working hard early in the mornings (6:30am) and late at night, beating the heat to complete the bright and colourful art work.

All tests are undertaken by an independent testing laboratory AWQC. Tests are taken monthly.

Other tests for Alkalinity and Chlorine are taken three times a day but the Coliform Count (Ecoli bacteria) are the most important result. Results for November, December 2017 and January 2018 can be found in the Council Agenda for January 23rd 2018.

High level expertise has been sourced from Violia and Water Utilities to review the operation of both the Reverse Osmosis (RO) and Sewerage Treatment Plant (SWT) plants respectively and to make recommendations to the Council on the manner in which the human resource requirements can be reviewed under an automated RO treatment system and how the operating costs are assessed going forward. The advice also enables detailed operating procedures to be prepared for new employees.

We would like to thank the community in identifying and reporting any issues and their patience while we resolved any faults around town.

New Equipment for the Water Supply Department

New pumps for the distribution network will be installed in the coming days. This will be a progressive instalation of four (4) new pumps, replacing the existing pumps which were installed in 1985.

The new generators for the borefield have arrived and installation will be occuring in the coming weeks.
